Ordinance Number 11

ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ERECTION OR DISPLAY OF COMMERCIAL SIGNS, SIGNBOARDS, OR BILLBOARDS IN QUEZON CITY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City,

That:

SECTION 1. No person, company or corporation shall construct, erect or place near public ways, grounds, or streets, or elsewhere in Quezon City, for the display of any sign, electric or otherwise, or for the erection or maintenance of billboards or structures of whatever kind for the display of said signs, or posters or other pictorial or reading matter, except when the same are displayed at a place or places where the office, clinic or business advertised thereby, is in whole or in part conducted, without first obtaining a permit therefor from the Mayor and without first paying a license for the same to the City Treasurer.

Sec. 2. If after proper investigation, the Mayor shall decide that any sign, signboard, billboard or any advertising media erected or displayed anywhere in Quezon City is offensive to the sight or is otherwise a nuisance, the Mayor or the person in charge therefor shall be ordered to remove the same within a period of 10 days from the date of the decision of the Mayor, and should the owner or the person in charge therefor fail to remove the same within this section provided, the same may be ordered removed by the Mayor, and the expenses incident to such removal shall become lawful charge against the owner or the person responsible therefor, without prejudice to any action which may be instituted against the person, company or corporation responsible.

Sec. 3. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Pesos (P200.00) or by imprisonment for not more than Six (6) months, or by both, in the discretion of the court.

Sec. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect on its passage.
