Ordinance Number 11

MERCIAL SIGNS, SIGNBOARDS, OR BILLBOARDS IN QUEZON CITY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of quezon City,

SECTION 1. No person, company or corporation shall truct, erect or place near public ways, grounds, or pes, or elsewhere in Quezon City, for the display of eign, electric or otherwise, or for the prection or tenance of billboards or structures of whatever kind the display of said signs, or posters or other pical or reading matter, except when the same are disted at a place or places where the office, clinic or less advertised thereby, is in whole or in part consists advertised thereby, is in whole or in part consists and without first obtaining a permit therefor from the same city Treasurer.

Sec. 2. If after proper investigation, the Mayor shall that any sign, signboard, billboard or any advermed a rected or displayed anywhere in Queson City Itensive to the sight or is otherwise a muisance, the row or the person in charge therefor shall be ordered to the same within a period of 10 days from the eff the decision of the Mayor, and should the owner the person in charge therefor fail to remove the same this section provided, the same may be ordered red by the Mayor, and the expenses incident to such that shall become lawful charge against the owner or person responsible therefor, without prejudice to any item which may be instituted against the person, company corporation responsible.

Sec. 3. Any violation of the provisions of this Ornance shall be punished by a fine of not more than mandred Pesos (\$200.00) or by imprisonment for not than Six (6) months, or by both, in the discretion the court.

ec. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect on its passage.
