ORDINANCE numbered 13.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE NEEDS OF THE SERVICE OF COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF ALL GARBAGE, REFUSE, THE CONTENTS OF CLOSETS, CESSPOOLS, AND OTHER OFFENSIVE AND DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES WITHIN THE QUEZON CITY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, by Section 16(b) of Commonwealth Act No. 502, the City Engineer of Quezon City is charged with the duty to collect and dispose of all garbage, refuse, the contents of closets and cesspools and all other offensive and dangerous substances within the said city;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid City Engineer invited the attention of the City Council to the necessity of immediately undertaking this work in the interest of the health and convenience of the inhabitants of the city;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY,

SECTION 1.- The sum of Ten Thousand Pesos (\$10,000) plus such thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the sum made available under Section 4 of Commonwealth Act No. 502, for the expenses of collection and disposal of all garbage, refuse, the contents of closets, cesspools, and all other offensive and dangerous substances within Quezon City, during the period from November 1, 1939 to June 30, 1940, as follows:

1. For purchase of equipments -	
2 - 7 T trucks, complete, with appropriate bodies	— \$5,400.00
2. For salaries of personnel -	
2 drivers @ \$40.00 a month each	560.00
6 garbage men @ \$30.00 a month each	1,260.00
3. For operating expenses -	
Fuel, lubrication, and repair services	— 2,721.00
	Total expenses —
	\$10,781.00

SEC. 2.- Any unappropriated balance of all the appropriations herein made on June 30, 1940, shall revert to the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the Treasury.

SEC. 3.- This ordinance shall take effect on the day it is passed.
