ORDINANCE Numbered 10.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (\$4,500.00) FOR THE NECESSARY EXPENSES OF MAKING A TOPOGRAPHIC SURVEY OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Vice-Mayor Vicente Fragata explained to the Council that, in order that the ~~Government~~ works may be able to prepare a development plan for Quezon City, it is necessary that a topographic survey thereof be made;

Be it ordained by the City Council of ~~Quezon~~ City, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$4,500.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the sum made available under Section 4 of Commonwealth Act No. 502, for the expenses of making a topographic survey of ~~Quezon~~ City.

SEC. 2. The sum set aside in this Ordinance shall be expended solely for the specific purpose for which appropriated, and for no other.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on its passage.
