ORDINANCE Numbered 17.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIVE THOUSAND  
FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (\$5,500.00) FOR THE Malaria  
Aeroplane FOR THE CONTROL OF MALARIA IN MANILA  
CITY.

WHEREAS, Councilor Faustino S. Aguilar, in his capacity as Director of Health, informed the Council of the need for additional aircraft for malaria control in Manila City:

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila  
City, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$5,500.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the sum made available under Section 4 of Commonwealth Act No. 508, for the expenses of effectively controlling malaria in the City.

SEC. 2. The sum set aside in this Ordinance shall be expended solely for the specific purpose for which appropriated, and for no other.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect on its passage.
