ORDINANCE Numbered 20.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE MANUFACTURE, SALE AND EXPLOSION OF FIRECRACKERS WITHIN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, in the past it has been the sad experience in many communities, particularly in the City of Manila, that persons are injured and some killed by reason of the explosion of firecrackers during Christmas and New Year's celebrations and other occasions of festivities.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. No person, company or corporation shall manufacture or sell or cause to be sold firecrackers in Quezon City.

SEC. 2. It shall also be unlawful for any person to explode or fire or cause to be exploded firecrackers.

SEC. 3. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00), or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or by both, in the discretion of the court.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect on its passage.
