ORDINANCE NUMBER 24.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE CITY TREASURER OF QUEZON CITY AT P6,400.00 PER MONTH AND PROVIDING AN APPENDIX THEREUPON

WHEREAS, in a Said Indorsement of January 13, 1940, concurred in by the City Mayor, City Treasurer Pie Padrosa asks for the reconsideration of the action of his original request taken by this Council in its last meeting disapproving the provision of salary of P6,400.00 per annum for the position of the City Treasurer of Quezon City so that a full-time incumbent may be appointed to succeed him;

WHEREAS, the said City Treasurer, in presenting said Request, has manifested that his original petition was made in accordance with plans of the Secretary of Finance to place at this time a full-time incumbent in the Treasurer's Office in Quezon City and of the Secretary to the President to assign to him additional duties and functions in connection with his work as Financial Assistant in the Executive Office;

WHEREAS, he further informs that the organization of the various departments and offices of the City Government has now been terminated; that the said departments and offices are now normally functioning; and that both the volume of work now obtaining in the Treasurer's Office in Quezon City and the conflict of the various requirements of the service upon his time justify now the appointment of a full-time City Treasurer;

WHEREAS, this Council was reluctant to act upon this request when originally presented, and in fact disapproved the same at its last session for the reason that the present arrangement is economical to the City and that notwithstanding his other duties in the Office of the President City Treasurer Pie Padrosa has been discharging the work of the Treasurer's Office with marked capability, industry and efficiency, but that in view of the reasons hereinabove set forth, there seems to be no other recourse than to approve the same;

WHEREAS, in view of the fact that, with the appointment of a full-time city treasurer, this Council is of the belief that for the present there will be very little need, if any, of the services of an assistant city treasurer;

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City,

SECTION 1. The position of City Treasurer of Quezon City is hereby provided a salary at P6,400.00 per annum.

SEC. 2. The position of Assistant City Treasurer is hereby abolished, and the unexpended balance of the appropriation corresponding thereto under Item 10, Schedule E, Estimate No. 2, Office of the City Treasurer,

ART. 3. In addition to the revenues provided in Section 8 of this Ordinance, there is hereby further appropriated from the funds pertaining to the City which are not otherwise appropriated, such further amount as will be necessary to cover the salary of the new city treasurer for the period from his assumption of office to June 30, 1940, at the rate herein provided, plus the share of the City in his insurance premium.

ART. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect on the date the new City Treasurer shall qualify and enter upon the performance of his duties.

Approved on January 16, 1940, by three members of the Council with Councillor Alejandro Roos, Sr. abstaining from voting. Vice-Mayor Vicente Fraguete was absent.
