ORDINANCE Numbered 27.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF P1,725.00 TO
PAY THE SALARIES OF TEMPORARY CLERKS AND TYPISTS
IN THE CITY ASSESSOR'S OFFICE HELPING IN THE AS-
SESSMENT WORK AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2, series of 1939, of
the City Council, the City Treasurer has been author-
ized to employ such number of typists for the purpose
of copying the records of tax declarations covering
real property and improvements now comprised within
the jurisdiction of Jason City from their original
in the Offices of the Municipal Treasurers of San
Juan, Mandaluyong, Calocan, and Marikina;

WHEREAS, by requirement of law, it becomes neces-
sary for the City Assessor to employ temporary clerks
in connection with the assessment work in the City;

Be it ordained by the City Council of Jason City,
that:

SECTION 1. The sum of P1,725.00, or as much there-
of as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from
the various estimated sources of revenue of Jason
City to be expended as follows:

Salaries of temporary clerks and typists (assessment work) -----	P1,625.00
Illumination service (Office of the City Assessor) -----	100.00
T o t a l -----	<u>P1,725.00</u>

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on its
passage.
