

ORDINANCE Numbered 22.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF PESO 6,694.00  
FROM THE VARIOUS ESTIMATED SOURCES OF REVENUE  
TO COVER THE OVERDRAFT IN THE EXPENSES OF THE  
GOVERNMENT OF QUEZON CITY AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Treasurer informed the City Council that as a result of the various appropriations already made, there is an overdraft of P13,694.00 as follows:
