ORDINANCE Numbered 29.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE HANGING OR DISPLAYING  
OF CLOTHES OR OTHER UNDECENTLY OBJECTS TO PUB-  
LIC VIEW.


Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City,  
that:

SECTION 1. Prohibition.- It shall be unlawful for any person to hang, display, or expose to public view, on the window or other place fronting a public place, clothes or other objects which are offensive to the sight.

SEC. 2. Penalty for violation.- Any person found guilty of a violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than two hundred pesos, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court. In case no person could be found responsible for such violation, then the clothes or objects so hung, displayed or exposed to public view shall be confiscated and forfeited, and shall be treated and disposed of as articles used in the commission of an offense.

SEC. 3. Effectivity.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
