AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTH.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

Section 1. Birth certificates; for whom issued, and form.—Birth certificates for children of less than one year of age, shall be issued gratis, which certificate shall be in the following form:

- Sec. 2. Birth certificates: how and when furnished.—
 That for the purpose above-mentioned, upon the presentation of a birth certificate, the person presenting the same should be asked by the official concerned if he or she desires to be furnished with a copy of the aforesaid certificate and in the affirmative case, the same must be issued.
- Sec. 3. Birth certificate: Form of: and fee.— Certificates of births for children over the age of One (1) year shall be issued in Municipal Form No. 102 (Revised 1939) and for the issuance of the same, a fee of ONE 'Fl.00) PESO shall be charged for each.

Sec. 4. Effectivity. This Ordinance shalltake effect upon its passage.
