ORDINANCE Numbered 59

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P2,329.30
FOR THE CREATION OF THE POSITIONS OF ONE
TEACHER-NURSE AND ONE CLERK-STENOGRAPHER AND
FOR THE PURCHASE OF FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT
IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, the Division Superintendent of Schools, in his letter dated July 5, 1940, to the City Council, thru His Honor, the Mayor, made manifestations that in the preparation of the General Budget of Quezon City for the fiscal year 1940-1941 certain items were not included in their original recommendation;

WHEREAS, the Council, after deliberating thereon, realized the importance and necessity of authorizing said items;

WHEREAS, the Division Superintendent of Schools recommended the amount of P2,329.30 to cover the said items;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

SECTION 1. The amount of P2,329.30 is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated funds of Quezon City, to cover the following items in the Office of the City Schools in Quezon City:

I. For the Office of the City Schools:

1. Salary of Personnel:

One teacher-nurse	P840.00
One clerk-stenographer ...	720.00
3% Gov't contribution to insurance system	<u>46.80</u>
