ORDINANCE Numbered 77.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ₱1,500.00  
OUT OF THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS OF QUEZON CITY  
TO DEFRAY THE COST OF REMODELLING THE BUILDING  
WHICH WAS PURCHASED TO HOUSE THE EMERGENCY DIS-  
PENSARY OF QUEZON CITY REFERRED TO IN ORDINANCE  
NO. 64.

WHEREAS, the City Mayor made verbal manifesta-  
tions that the building which was purchase to house  
the emergency dispensary referred to in Ordinance No.  
64, of Quezon City, needs remodelling

WHEREAS, the estimate of the cost for remodel-  
ling the same is ₱1,500.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Coun-  
cil of Quezon City that:

Section 1. The amount of ₱1,500.00 is hereby set  
aside out of the unappropriated funds of Quezon City  
to defray the cost of remodelling the building which  
was purchase to house the emergency dispensary of Que-  
zon City.

Section 2. The amount set aside in this Ordinance  
shall be expended solely for the specific purpose for  
which authorized and for no other.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon  
its passage.
