ORDINANCE Numbered 78

AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE THE AMOUNT OF \$250.00 OUT OF THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS OF QUEZON CITY TO DEFRAY THE COST OF COMPLETING THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE STOREROOM FOR THE OFFICE OF THE CITY TREASURER.

WHEREAS, the City Treasurer, in his letter of August 12, 1940, to the City Council, manifested the necessity of an additional appropriation of \$250.00 in order to complete the reconstruction of the store-room for his Office, referred to in Ordinance No. 52, in view of the fact that the amount authorized in the said Ordinance is not sufficient;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

Section 1. The amount of \$250.00 is hereby set aside out of the unappropriated funds of Quezon City to defray the cost of completing the reconstruction of the said storeroom.

Section 2. The amount set aside in this Ordinance shall be expended solely for the specific purpose for which authorized and for no other.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
