## ORDINANCE Numbered 79

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ITEM 1(9). PAGE 4, UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY HEALTH OFFICER, ORDINANCE NO. 55, OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the City Health Officer, in his letter of August 9, 1940, to the City Council, made representations to the effect that the chauffeur of the Health Department who drives the jitney for the medical officers of Quezon City in their inspections of cadavers and of insanitary conditions in the City that require immediate investigation, is only receiving a salary of P480 per annum which he considers a very meager compensation, considering that he is on duty almost 12 hours every day, including Sundays and holidays;

WHEREAS, the Health Departments is very much benefited by the employment of the incumbent chauffeur
for he is at the same time an auto mechanic who can
make minor repairs of the jitney, thereby saving the
City further expenses in connection with said regular;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

Section 1. Item I(9), page 4, under the Office of the City Health Officer, Ordinance No. 55, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"9. One Chauffeur at ₱600 per annum."

Section 2. This amendment shall take effect on November 7, 1940.

Section, 3. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to set aside so much of the amount that may be necessary for the increase of the salary alloted to this item until the end of the fiscal year 1941, out of the unappropriated funds of Quezon City.
