ORDINANCE numbered 84 +

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF PESOS ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY FIVE AND NO CENTS FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS OF THE CITY FOR THE PURCHASE OF SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS, FURNITURE AND OFFICE EQUIPMENT AND THE COST OF THEIR REPAIR IN THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE IN KUNSON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police, in his letter of August 31, 1940, to the City Council, made representations that the funds set aside under Ordinance No. 80 for the purchase of supplies and materials, furniture and office equipment in his Office, as well as the cost of their repair during the current fiscal year would not be sufficient to cover the entire amount needed in his office for said purposes;

WHEREAS, the City Council, after considering the recommendations of the Chief of Police as to the estimate of additional appropriation for the purchase of supplies and materials, furniture and office equipment, and the cost of their repair for the current fiscal year, believes that the amount of P2,375.00 is necessary therefor;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Kunson City that:

Section 1. The amount of P2,375.00, itemized below, is hereby appropriated for the purchase of supplies and materials, furniture and office equipment, and for the cost of their repair:

Purchase of supplies and materials -	P1,025.00
Purchase of furniture and office equipment -----	700.00
Six tear gas double-shot club-guns -----	P300.00
One Hundred Tear gas bullets, cal. .30 G PG.80- 80.00	
Five Pneumatic rubber tires for the station wagon of the Office of the Chief of Police @ P18.00- 90.00	
Amount to supplement Item LII(24), "Furniture and Office equipment", Ordinance No. 80 -----	P30.00
Repair of equipment -----	60.00
TOTAL -----	P2,375.00

Section 2. The amount set aside in this Ordinance shall be expended solely for the specific purposes herein authorized.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
