ORDINANCE Numbered 85

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P1,500.00 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS OF QUEZON CITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING THE POSITIONS OF ONE FULL-TIME DENTIST AND ONE HELPER WITH COMPENSATIONS AT THE RATE OF P80.00 AND P25.00 PER MONTH, RESPECTIVELY, AND FOR THE PURCHASE OF NECESSARY MATERIALS, SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the City Health Officer has informed the City Council that the Red Cross dentist renders service in Quezon City not more than 3 days out of every school year and that this is rather a very short time to give the desired effect in order to correct the dental defects common among school children in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the City Health Officer has likewise informed that the National Charity Clinic dentist only comes to Quezon City once every 15 months for a period of not longer than 1 month and even this is also considered inadequate taking into account the dental needs of the Quezon City population;

WHEREAS, the City Council, after careful deliberation, realizes the importance and necessity of having one full-time dentist in Quezon City for the good of the general public as well as of the school population, as recommended by the City Health Officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

Section 1. The amount of P1,500.00, itemized below, is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated funds of Quezon City, as follows:

Section 2. The amount set aside in this Ordinance shall be expended solely for the specific purposes for which authorized.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
