ORDINANCE Numbered 89

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE LICENSE FEE OF BICYCLES WHICH ARE OWNED, KEPT OR USED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF QUEZON CITY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

Section. No person shall own, possess or maintain any bicycle, either for private use or for hire, within thelimits of Quezon City, without first securing a license therefor from the City Treasurer.

Section 2. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the license year shall be from January 1 to December 31, of each year, which shall be secured or renewed within thirty days from the beginning of each license year.

Section 3. For every license issued under the provisions of the last preceding section, the sum of \$\frac{2}{3}\text{.00}\$ per annum shall be collected and the corresponding certificate issued together with a plate number which shall be placed or displayed on the rear portion of the bicycle exposed to public view.

Section 4. No license shall be issued except upon written evidence of ownership or legal possession of any bicycle satisfactory to the City Treasurer or his authorized representative, a true copy of which shall by filed in the office of the latter.

Section 5. Any person who shall knowingly or will-fully refuse to secure a license for any bicycle under his possession or control within the limits of Quezon City shall be punished by a fine not exceeding five pesos or by imprisonment not exceeding five days or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

Section 6. Any other violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall subject the owner or the person in possession or control of any bicycle to the payment of the license for the current year plus an additional surcharge of fifty (50) per cent.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
