ORDINANCE Numbered 31 +

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 80 OF QUEZON CITY SO AS TO FIX THE SALARY OF A DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY PROVIDED THEREIN AT THE RATE OF P1,220.00 INSTEAD OF P1,800.00 PER ANNUM.

WHEREAS, the Honorable, the Undersecretary of Justice and the Deputy Commissioner of the Budget have informed His Honor, the Mayor, that the position of Deputy City Attorney created under Ordinance No. 80 of Quezon City falls under Grade 3 of the Salary Standardization Law (Commonwealth Act No. 803);

AND WHEREAS, under the said Ordinance No. 80 of Quezon City the salary provided for the said position has been fixed at P1,800.00, while the minimum salary for positions under Grade 3 is P1,220.00 per annum;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 80 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 2. The position of Law Clerk at the rate of P1,200.00 per annum provided for in Item I(3) under the Office of the City Attorney, page 7, of Ordinance No. 55, is hereby suppressed and in lieu thereof, the position of one Deputy City Attorney with compensation at the rate of P1,220.00 per annum is hereby created."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
