ORDINANCE Numbered 93 -

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF P400.00 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS OF QUEZON CITY TO DEFRAY THE COST AND INSTALLATION OF AN UNDERGROUND TANK FOR GASOLINE.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer, in his letter of October 4, 1940 to the City Council, manifested the necessity and advantages of having a gasoline pump for the exclusive use of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, he also stated that the Standard Vaseline Company has consented to loan the City a gasoline pump free of charge on condition that the City provides an underground tank which is estimated to cost P355.00 and P60.00 for its installation;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

Section 1. The sum of P400.00 is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated funds of Quezon City to defray the cost and installation of an underground tank for gasoline.

Section 2. The amount set aside in this Ordinance shall be expended solely for the specific purpose for which authorized.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
