ORDINANCE Numbered 97

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ₱31.50 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS OF QUEZON CITY TO PAY THE COST OF ELECTRICAL SERVICES FOR ONE STREETLIGHT TO BE INSTALLED AT THE CORNER OF BAUTISTA AND ALBAY STREETS, QUEZON CITY, FOR THE PERIOD FROM OCTOBER, 1940 TO JUNE, 1941, INCLUSIVE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

Section 1. The amount of ₱31.50 is hereby set aside from the unappropriated funds of Quezon City to cover the cost of electrical services for one streetlight to be installed at the corner of Bautista and Albay Street, Quezon City, for the period from October, 1940 to June, 1941, inclusive.

Section 2. The sum set aside in this Ordinance shall be expended solely for the specific purpose for which authorized and for no other.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
