ORDINANCE Numbered 108

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OWNERS, MANAGERS OR OTHER PERSONS IN CHARGE OF SUBDIVISIONS LOCATED WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY TO MAINTAIN AND FILL UP THOSE PORTIONS OF THEIR LANDS AND STREETS WHICH DO NOT CONFORM TO A GRADE NECESSARY FOR PROPER SANITATION.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of any owner, manager or other person in charge of any subdivision within the jurisdiction of Quezon City to fill up to a grade necessary for proper sanitation any and all lands, streets and premises within said subdivision which may be declared and duly reported by the City Health Officer as being insanitary or which, in the opinion of the said officer, the public health or welfare may require.

SEC. 2. It shall be unlawful for any owner, manager, or other person in charge of any subdivision to allow or cause to be allowed undrained any pool or stagnant water in any street or lot within their subdivision.

SEC. 3 Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than ₱50.00 nor more than ₱200.00 or by imprisonment for not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
