ORDINANCE Numbered 110

AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE THE SUM OF P5,700.00 OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY, OUT OF ANY FUNDS OF QUEZON CITY, NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED, TO DEFRAY THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROPOSED PUBLIC SANITARY TOILETS IN QUEZON CITY TO BE LOCATED NAMELY: ONE IN GALAS, TWO IN LA LOMA, ONE IN BARRIO MALAMIG, ONE IN DILIMAN AT P1,000.00 EACH AND ONE AT SANTOL AT P700.00.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

Section 1. The sum of P5,700.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby set aside out of any funds of Quezon City, not otherwise appropriated, to defray the construction of the proposed public sanitary toilets in Quezon City to be located as follows:
