ORDINANCE NUMBERED 113 ✓

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OWNERS OR OTHER PERSONS IN CHARGE OF ANY BUILDING OR "SARI-SARI" STORE TO ~~KEEP OR DEPOSIT~~ WITHIN THE PREMISES OF THEIR ~~RESPECTIVE BUILDING OR STORE~~ MORE THAN TWO CANS OF PETROLEUM, ALCOHOL OR ANY OTHER COMBUSTIBLE MATERIAL.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for "sari-sari" store owners, managers, or other persons in charge of the same and who are engaged in the sale by retail of such articles or materials like petroleum, alcohol or any like combustible article or material, to keep or deposit or allow or consent to the keeping or depositing within the premises of their respective stores, more than two cans of petroleum, alcohol or any like combustible article or material unless said buildings or stores are provided with a fire-proof vault or warehouse duly certified by the City Engineer and approved by the City Mayor and upon payment of the corresponding license as provided for in Ordinance No. 10 of Quezon City, which vault or warehouse shall in no case be less than twenty (20) meters away from the nearest building.

Section 2. The provision of the preceding section is applicable to owners or persons in charge of any building or store whether used for residential, commercial or industrial purposes.

Section 3. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) or by imprisonment for not more than Three Months, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
