AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OWNERS, OR OTHER PERSONS IN CHARGE OR IN POSSESSION OF ANY RESIDENTIAL LOT TO CLEAN THE SAME AND REMOVE THEREFROM SURPLUS GRASS OR ANY UNSIGHTLY BRUSH OR RUBBISH.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

Section 1. All owners or other persons in charge or in possession of any residential lot in Quezon City shall clean or cause to be cleaned their respective lots of any surplus grass and other unsightly brush or rubbish within thirty (30) days from the date a notice to this effect has been received from the City Engineer or the City Health Officer of Quezon City or their respective authorized representatives.

Section 2. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than P200.00 or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
