Section 1. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 33 of Quezon City is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

\*Dec. 7. Rooms for human habitation room with a seiling height of less than three (3) meters shall be constructed or used for human habitation. Dwelling houses shall have at least four (4) square meters of floor space and shall have a window or windows facing an open space corresponding to at least oneeighth (1/8) of the floor area. All apertures which can be kept open for ventilation purposes, leading to the outside air (not those leading into another room or inclosure) shall be considered as a window for the purpose of this section. Provided, however, that when in the opinion of the City Engineer there is sufficient ventilation in any room of a proposed building to be constructed, and his recommendation receives the approval of the City Mayor, the ceiling height of parts thereof may be lower than 3 meters but in no case shall it be less than 2.25 meters."

Section 2. Any existing ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
