ORDINANCE Numbered 136

ORDINANCE CHARGING A FEE OF FIVE CENTAVOS (P0.05) PER KILO ON ALL MEAT COMING FROM MUNICIPAL OR PRIVATE ABATTOIRS OUTSIDE OF QUEZON CITY WHICH IS SOLD IN ANY MARKET OR PLACE WHERE FOOD IS SOLD WITHIN THE DISTRICTS OR BARrios OF SAN FRANCISCO DEL MONTE, BALINTAWAK AND LA LAMA.

WHEREAS, His Honor, the Mayor, has informed the City Council that as per letter of the City Meat Inspector, dated February 8, 1941, the city slaughterhouse at San Francisco del Monte is now equipped with the necessary appurtenances for the slaughtering of large animals;

WHEREAS, the City Council realizes that the said slaughterhouse is quite far from all the other sections of Quezon City, with the exception of those comprised within San Francisco del Monte, Balintawak and La Loma;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City that:

Section 1. All meat coming from municipal or licensed private abattoirs outside of Quezon City shall be charged a fee of five centavos (P0.05) per kilo upon its sale in any market or place where food is sold within the districts or barrios of San Francisco del Monte, Balintawak and La Loma, and shall also be accompanied by a permit issued and signed by the Meat Inspector of the establishment certifying as to its wholesomeness and fitness for human consumption; provided that as soon as the new abattoir now under construction at Maribentay, San Francisco del Monte, is completed and ready for use the provisions of this section shall be applicable to the entire Quezon City.

Section 2. All Ordinances and Resolutions or parts thereof which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
