AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING AN ANNUAL LICENSE OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS, PAYABLE QUARTERLY, FOR EVERY SIGN, SIGNBOARD, BILLBOARD, ETC., ERECTED OR DISPLAYED IN QUEZON CITY FOR ADVERTISING PURPOSES AT PLACES OTHER THAN WHERE THE OFFICE OR BUSINESS ADVERTISED THEREBY IS CONDUCTED.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. For every sign, signboard, billboard, etc., erected or displayed in Quezon City for advertising purposes at places other than where the office or business advertised thereby is conducted, the owner or concessionaire thereof duly permitted by the City Engineer to display or erect the same, shall pay to the City Treasurer an annual license of one hundred fifty pesos, payable quarterly.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
