The sum of one hundred twenty-five pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise apprepriated, to be made available for the purchase of the following which will be furnished the "Galas Fire Patrol": Two (2) fire axes ..... \$ 5.00 Four (4) hooks with 20 ft chain ..... Two (2) coils rope, 30 meters each coil ..... Twelve (12) pails, 5 gals. . \_ SEC. 2. The amount set aside in this Ordinance shall be spent specifically for the purpose for which authorized and for no other. SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
