ORDINANCE Numbered 145

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF EIGHT PESOS
TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO COVER THE ELECTRICAL
SOMSUMPTION OF TWO 25-WATT ELECTRIC LIGHTS TO
BE INSTALLED IN THE PUBLIC TOILET AT GALAS,
FOR THE PERIOD FROM MARCH TO JUNE, 1941.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of eight pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the city treasurer not otherwise appropriated, to be made available to cover the electrical consumption of two 25-watt electric lights to be installed in the public toilet at Galas, for the period from March to June, 1941.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
