ORDINANCE Numbered 147

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF TWO
60-C.P. STREETLIGHTS, ONE AT THE CORNER OF
D. TUASON AND TANGAB STREETS, STA. MESA HEIGHTS,
AND THE OTHER ON M. E. POST NO. 22742 AT GALAS,
QUEZON CITY, AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWENTY-
ONE PESOS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THEIR ELECTRICAL
CONSUMPTION.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City,
that:

SECTION 1. The installation of one 60-c.p. street-
light at the corner of D. Tuason and Tangab Streets,
Sta. Mesa Heights, and another one also of 60-c.p. on
M. E. Post No. 22742 at Galas, Quezon City, is hereby
authorized.

SEC. 2. The sum of twenty-one pesos, or so much
thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out
of any funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise
appropriated, to be made available for the electrical
consumption of the said lights during the period from
April 1 to June 30, 1941.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its
passage.
