ORDINANCE Numbered 148

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE PESOS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE IN ADDITION TO THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED FORTY PESOS APPROPRIATED UNDER ORDINANCE NUMBERED 129 FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TWO PUMP WELLS AT BAGUMBAYAN AND UGONG NORTE, INCLUDING THE SHORT-AGE PLUS SURCHARGE.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has informed the City Council that the city's request for an insular aid to cover two-thirds of the cost of installation of the proposed two pump wells, one at Bagumbayan and the other at Ugong Norte, has been disapproved by the Director of Public Works;

WHEREAS, the installation of the said wells is very urgent and necessary inasmuch as the people in the said barriers have no source of safe drinking water at their place;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of five hundred seventy-five pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be made available in addition to the amount of four hundred forty pesos appropriated under Ordinance Numbered 129 for the installation of said proposed wells, including the shortage, plus surcharge.

SEC. 2. The amount set aside in this Ordinance shall be spent specifically for the purpose herein authorized and for no other.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
