ORDINANCE Numbered 151

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF THREE LIGHTS AT CERTAIN SECTIONS OF QUEZON CITY AND APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY-THREE PESOS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THEIR ELECTRICAL CONSUMPTION.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The installation of one 75-watt multiple light on Post No. 26575 at Sampaloc Avenue, Diliman; one 60-c.p. light at Poinsettia Road, Cubao; and another 60-c.p. light at Broadway corner 17th Street, is hereby authorized.

SEC. 2. The sum of thirty-three pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be made available for the electrical consumption of the said lights during the period from April 1 to June 30, 1941.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
