ORDINANCE Numbered 152

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF POSITIONS
OF THE NECESSARY PERSONNEL TO TAKE CHARGE AND
OPERATE THE QUEZON CITY SLAUGHTERHOUSE AND
STOCKYARD AT BAGOBANTAY, AND APPROPRIATING
THE NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The following positions are hereby created and authorized to take charge and operate the Quezon City slaughterhouse and stockyard at Bagobantay:

1. One Veterinarian (By detail)

2. One Lay Meat Inspector and Clerk at \$600 per annum.

3. Three Laborer-cleaners at \$1.00 each per day.

4. One Watchman-Janitor at ₹1.00 per day.

5. One Chauffeur at Pl.50 per day.

SEC. 2. Those under the first three items shall be under the direct supervision of the City Health Officer, and thd three laborers will help in the slaughterhouse immediately after slaughtering.

SEC. 3. Those under the last two items shall be under the direct supervision of the City Engineer, who shall have the care and custody of the slaughter-house and stockyard and the operation of the mean Van.

SEC. 4. The sum of three thousand six hundred thirty-five pesos and fifty centavos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the city treasury not other wise appropriated, to be made available as follows:

SEC. 5. The amount set aside in this Ordinance shall be spent specifically for the purpose herein authorized and for no other.

SEC. 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
