ORDINANCE Numbered 163

AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE THE SUM OF SIX HUNDRED PESOS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE PURCHASE OF MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT RECOMMENDED BY THE CITY HEALTH OFFICER FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE CITY SLAUGHTERHOUSE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of six hundred pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby set aside from the unexpended balance of the funds for the construction of the market and slaughterhouse at Bagobantay, to be made available for the purchase of materials and equipment recommended by the City Health Officer for the maintenance and operation of the city slaughterhouse.

SEC. 2. The amount appropriated in this Ordinance shall be spent solely for the purpose for which authorized and for no other.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
