ORDINANCE Numbered 164

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND PESOS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO MEET ALL EXPECTED EXPENSES COVERING TRANSPORTATION AND SUBSISTENCE THAT MAY BE FURNISHED THE MEMBERS OF THE VOLUNTEER GUARD OF QUEZON CITY WHEN CALLED INTO ACTIVE SERVICE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 337.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of two thousand pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any balance existing from the five per cent reserve in the general fund of the City, to be made available to meet all expected expenses covering transportation and subsistence that may be furnished the members of the Volunteer Guard of Quezon City when called into active service under the provisions of Executive Order No. 337.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
