ORDINANCE Numbered 165

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SIX PESOS TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO COVER THE SALARY OF TWO CITY EMPLOYEES DURING THEIR ABSENCE WHILE UNDER PROBATIONAL APPOINTMENT.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. The sum of six pesos, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be made available as follows: two pesos to Detective Crispino Avila covering his salary for June 8, 1940, at the rate of P60 a month; and four pesos to Pasciano C. Cantre, clerk, Office of the Chief of Police, representing his salary for June 17 to 19, 1940, at the rate of P40.00 a month, which sums were deducted from their salaries during their absence while under probational appointment and they are now entitled to the same, as regular and permanent employees of the city government.

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
