ORDINANCE Numbered 178

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL SUBDIVISION OWNERS TO ERECT
STREET NAME SIGNS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE SUBDIVISIONS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City
that:

SECTION 1.- It shall be the duty of the owners
of subdivisions in Quezon City to erect street name
signs at all intersections of the roads within their
standard plan prescribed by the City Engineer's Office
of Quezon City.

SEC. 2.- A standard plan of the street name sign
shall be given free of charge by the City Engineer
of Quezon City upon request of the subdivision owner.

SEC. 3.- Any person or corporation who shall fail
to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall
be punished upon conviction of a fine of not less than
P10.00 nor more than P200.00 or by imprisonment of not
more than six months or by both such fine and imprison-
ment in the discretion of the court; Provided, that in the
case of corporations the manager or person in charge
of the business shall be responsible therefor.

SEC. 4.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon
its passage.
