ORDINANCE NO. SP-119, S-93

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P452,000.00) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITIONAL SECOND FLOOR OF THE EXISTING BARANGAY HALL LOCATED AT BARANGAY BAGUMBAYAN, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the barangay hall located at Barangay Bagumbayan, Quezon City, currently functions as the multi-purpose hall for the barangay;

WHEREAS, the present structure is now dilapidated, having been in existence for more than ten (10) years;

WHEREAS, the barangay hall is being extensively used as a day care center and clinic which limits its use for other purposes;

WHEREAS, the additional second floor will house the Office of the Punong Barangay, the Barangay Council, and the Information Center;

WHEREAS, the construction of such hall is manifestly necessary and desirable for better public service to the residents therein;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.


