**ORDINANCE NO. SP-1152, 2002**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ADDITIONAL ONE 24-HOUR LYING-IN CLINIC IN EVERY DISTRICT IN QUEZON CITY.**

WHEREAS, it is the strong desire of the Quezon City government to make available to its citizenry, especially the less-privileged, affordable obstetrics and gynecology and related services on a 24-hour basis.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Section 1. All Districts in Quezon City are hereby required to establish and maintain an additional one 24-hour Lying-In Clinic which shall provide obstetrics/gynecology and related services to all residents in Quezon City.

Section 2. Pending the creation of regular plantilla positions, the City Health Officer is hereby directed to make the necessary arrangement for the assessment of medical personnel who will make the Lying-In Clinic operational; Provided, that subject to the availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations, the medical personnel mentioned herein may receive honoraria or allowances.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
