ORDINANCE NO. SP-**1938**, S-2009

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING FIVE (5) YEARS FRANCHISE TO ERNESTO BARCELONA FOR THE OPERATION OF A WET AND DRY MARKET LOCATED AT ABRA-CONGRESSIONAL AVENUE, BARANGAY RAMON MAGSAYSAY, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Market Code of 2000 provides that all public markets/slaughter houses must secure a franchise from the City Council;

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. SP-1271, S-2003, all markets and slaughterhouses existing prior to the effectivity of the Market Code are exempt from the regulatory requirements for the franchise, except from payment of the franchise tax;

WHEREAS, Abra-Congressional Market, through its owner and/or operator Ernesto Barcelona, has submitted an application and the requirements for the grant of franchise permit to operate a private market located at Abra-Congressional, Barangay Ramon Magsaysay, District I, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, Abra-Congressional Market has been in existence prior to the effectivity of the Market Code of Quezon City and is therefore exempt from the regulatory requirements for franchise, except from payment of the franchise tax;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY
IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. A franchise is hereby granted to Ernesto Barcelona to operate a private Wet and Dry market named "Abra-Congressional Market" located at Abra-Congressional Avenue, Barangay Ramon Magsaysay, District I, Quezon City.

SECTION 2. The franchise herein granted is subject to the conditions and limitations to be imposed and as required by the Market Code of 2000, and other City Ordinance and National Laws.

SECTION 3. The franchise granted herein shall be for a period of five (5) years.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after the date of approval of the City Mayor.
