ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2036, S-2010

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL INFORMATION-DISSEMINATION BOARD FOR ALL ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS APPROVED AND ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL IN THE ONE HUNDRED FORTY TWO (142) BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Section 28, Article II of the Philippine Constitution provides that subject to reasonable conditions prescribed by law, the State adopts and implements a policy of full disclosure of all its transactions involving public interest;

WHEREAS, it is a time immemorial principle that the citizenry have the privilege, if not the right to be informed of the actions of the duly constituted government, especially on the aspect affecting their rights;

WHEREAS, information is necessary to enable the members of the society to cope with the exigencies of the time and in order to adhere to the above mentioned principles. The approval of this ordinance will strengthen the vital link between constituents and the Quezon City Government.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Establishing the Quezon City Council Information-Dissemination Board as posting area for all the Ordinances and Resolutions Approved and Adopted by the City Council of Quezon City in the One Hundred Forty Two (142) Barangays in Quezon City.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE. The Quezon City Council Information-Dissemination Board shall serve as the posting area of all the Ordinances and Resolutions approved and adopted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod including other pertinent matters that could provide access to all concerns.

SECTION 3. DISTRIBUTION OF COPY. - The City Secretary, through the Office of the Barangay Operations Center, shall distribute copy of the approved Resolutions and Ordinances to all the 142 Barangays of Quezon City for posting in the designated areas;


SECTION 4. PENALTY. - Failure of the Barangay Captain to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to administrative liability.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. - Any provision of an existing City Ordinance, resolutions or rules and regulations found to be inconsistent herewith shall be deemed repealed, amended or modified accordingly. }




SECTION 6. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


