ORDINANCE

EXTENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE FIRE VICTIMS WHOSE HOUSES AND PROPERTIES WERE BURNED DOWN BY A BLAZE IN BARANGAY BALINGASA, QUEZON CITY ON NOVEMBER 25, 1992, APPROPRIATING THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF SIXTY-SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P67,500.00) FROM THE CALAMITY FUNDS OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT.
