WHEREAS, on January 22, 1990, by virtue of City  
Ordinance No. NC-130, S-90, the PMHA Road was tempo-  
rarily closed at certain hours for use as school  
grounds of the Flora Ylagan High School, Barangay  
Pinyahan;

WHEREAS, the temporary closure of the PMHA Road  
has provided the Flora Ylagan High School safe and  
spacious venue for its P.E., sports and other school-  
related activities;

WHEREAS, to date, the Flora Ylagan High School  
needs additional school grounds to accomodate its  
increasing annual enrollment, and the permanent  
closure of the PMHA Road could readily serve the  
purpose;

WHEREAS, the need to permanently close said road  
has been the subject of numerous request not only  
from the Barangay Council of Barangay Pinyahan as  
contained in its Resolution No. 3, S-1992, but also  
from the major parent-teacher-student organizations of  
Flora Ylagan High School such as the Parents-Teachers  
Association as contained in its Resolution No. 1, S-
