ORDINANCE
EXTENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE MAY 6 VICTIMS
OF FIRE THAT BURNED THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSES OF TWO
HUNDRED NINETY (290) FAMILIES AT BARANGAY TATALON,
AREA 21, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY AT TWO THOUSAND
PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY-OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND
PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY-RENTER/SHARER AND ALLOCATING THE SUM OF FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND
PESOS (P459,000.00) WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE
CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT
OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE SOURCE OF FUND THEREOF.
