ORDINANCE NO. SP-111, S-93

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS TO PUT ADEQUATE, SUFFICIENT AND COVERED TRASH RECEPTACLES AND ITS IMPLEMENTS AND ACCESSORIES WITHIN THE VICINITY OF THEIR ESTABLISHMENTS AND PROVIDING PENALTY AND/OR FINE FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, plastic food bags, cups or containers are frequently used in business establishments engaged in selling food and/or drinks, among others;

WHEREAS, used plastic food bags, cups or containers are usually found scattered within the area of these establishments due to lack of or absence of trash cans;

WHEREAS, these plastic waste products are not biodegradable and are the main causes of drainage clogging and flooding;

WHEREAS, there is a need to require all industrial and commercial establishments to put up or provide adequate, sufficient and covered trash receptacles and its implements and accessories within the vicinity of their establishments to prevent further occurrences of this situation;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. All industrial and commercial establishments doing business in Quezon City are required to put adequate, sufficient and covered trash
