WHEREAS, on December 4, 1992 registered voters of the katipunan ng kabataan in every barangay throughout the country elected the chairman and members of their respective Sangguniang Kabataan;

WHEREAS, under the provision of the Local Government Code of 1991, unlike the sanguniang kabataan chairman "who shall automatically serve as an ex-officio member of the sanguniang kabataan upon his assumption of Office", and "as such, he shall exercise the same powers, discharge the same duties and functions, and enjoy the same privileges as the regular sanguniang barangay members", the sangguniang kabataan members are not entitled to the said powers and privileges;

WHEREAS, while modest financial assistance to these sangguniang kabataan members in Quezon City may not adequately fill their needs, it can however spell
