ORDINANCE NO. SP-_____, 1-94

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN THOUSAND PESOS (P10,000.00) TO BUDO VOLUNTEER MANUEL LEGASPI, WHO PASSED AWAY WHILE CONDUCTING NIGHT DUTY LAST JANUARY 11, 1994, THE AMOUNT TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE 1994 BUDGET OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR, OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY.
