"give full support to the improvement of the State to well-being of disabled persons and their integration into the mainstream of society xxx";

WHEREAS, cognizant of said principle, the Congress of the Philippines jointly enacted Republic Act No. 7277 otherwise known as the Magna Carta for Disabled Persons, which provides for "the rehabilitation, self-development and self-reliance of disabled persons and their integration into the mainstream of society and for other purposes";

WHEREAS, under the said Act, local government units are mandated to "promote the establishment of organizations of disabled persons in their respective territorial jurisdiction;"
