WHERLAS, the State recognises the indispensable role of cooperatives in national development;

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy of the State to promote the viability and growth of cooperatives as instrument of equity, social justice and economic development;

otherwise known as the Cooperative Code of the Philippines provides, inter alia, that it is "the Philippines provides, inter alia, that it is "the policy of the State to foster the creation and growth of cooperatives as a practical vehicle for promoting self-reliance and harmessing receive power towards the attainment of economic development and social justice. X X X";

the City Government is mandated to promote the establishment and operation of people's organizations. NGO's, and the private sector to make them active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy, particularly in the implementation of projects, programs and activities involving, among others, the delivery of basic services and facilities, joint ventures and cooperative programs or undertakings, preferential treatment for cooperative development;
